

SDG 15: Life on Land

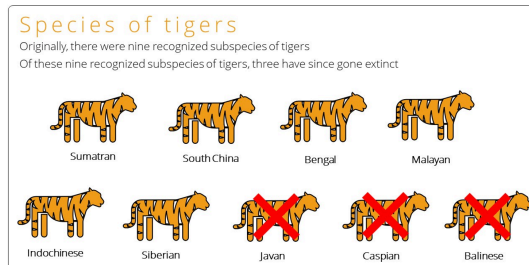
Grades 3-5

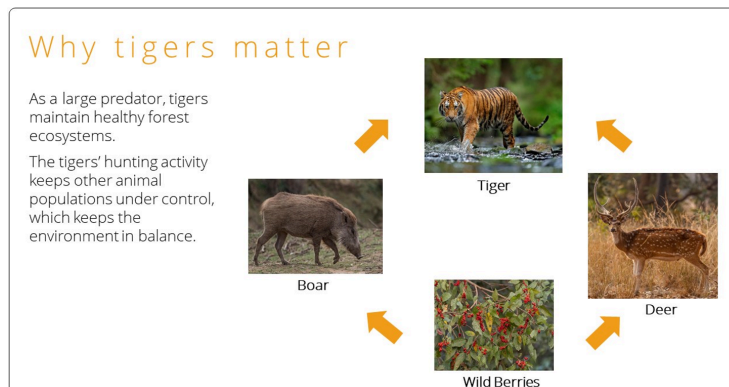
