<u>Description:</u> The EPA has many publications on every environmental subject that you can download or order. - This particular lesson plan focuses on acid rain; with a timeline of the EPA's acid rain project, what acid rain is, its negative impacts, etc.
- Infographic that illustrates how electricity is provided oftentimes by burning fossil fuels, and how those processes contribute to acid rain
- This guide also provides many vocabulary terms with definitions related to the concepts discussed
- The guide, while intended mostly for use by educators, also contains pages that could be distributed as class readings
- The guide outlines ways that students can actually help combat this issue, empowering them to see themselves as part of a solution
- The most useful section of the guide is the detailed experiments provided, all directly related to the concept of acid rain, with observation questions included
 - Testing pH of water and other common substances
 - Making natural pH meters
 - Soil buffering with coffee filters
 - Acid rain impacts on plant growth
