Founded in 2010 by nine leading international organizations in the Greater Philadelphia region, the Global Philadelphia Association (GPA) is dedicated to promoting and enhancing the region's global profile and broadening the appreciation of our heritage through collaboration.

With the support of our sponsors, GPA delivers on the promise of bringing together international activity in Philadelphia, fostering collaboration and supporting globally-minded actions and solutions. Through strategic partnerships, GPA strengthens the city's and region's ability to engage with global developments while enhancing their international connections.

In 2015, GPA used its unique position to organize the city's successful bid to become the first World Heritage City in the United States. We are eligible for this distinction because Independence Hall is designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, possessing what UNESCO calls "outstanding universal value" as a beacon of democracy. With this designation, Philadelphia joined a prestigious network of more than 300 World Heritage cities across the globe, reflecting our status as a leading place to visit, live, and do business.

GPA manages a network of more than 200 member organizations comprised of businesses, organizations, and individuals across the Greater Philadelphia region. Through a multi-tiered effort, the collective reaches 1,350,000 internationally-minded Philadelphians who are global players at the state, national, and world levels.

The World Heritage City Program is a series of fundamental and transformative initiatives designed to make use of our new designation. The Project focuses on the four critical parts of the GPA mission:

- Preserving and Celebrating Philadelphia's Historical and Cultural Assets
- Building World Heritage City Awareness and Ownership
- Educating Global Kids with Roots
- Extending Philadelphia's Global Reach

GPA is devoted to keeping the public apprised of our work on the Project through trimesterly progress reports, descriptions of project activities, and its website. On our website, the Emerging International Journalists Program program highlights stories and international activity in the region.

The World Heritage City Celebration Dinner is a major event held each September that features live entertainment, a prominent honoree and guest speaker and the gathering of business, civic, and community leaders from the Greater Philadelphia region and around the globe. It marks both Philadelphia's global status and the anniversary of the founding of the Organization of World Heritage Cities. The event links Philadelphia and 300 other World Heritage cities in a simultaneous celebration.

World Heritage Week is celebrated annually. This annual event builds awareness of Philadelphia's World Heritage City status among all city residents. Celebrated the last week of each May, the celebration is carried out at different locations in Philadelphia each year. It is a signature event for Philadelphia's international and civic community.
