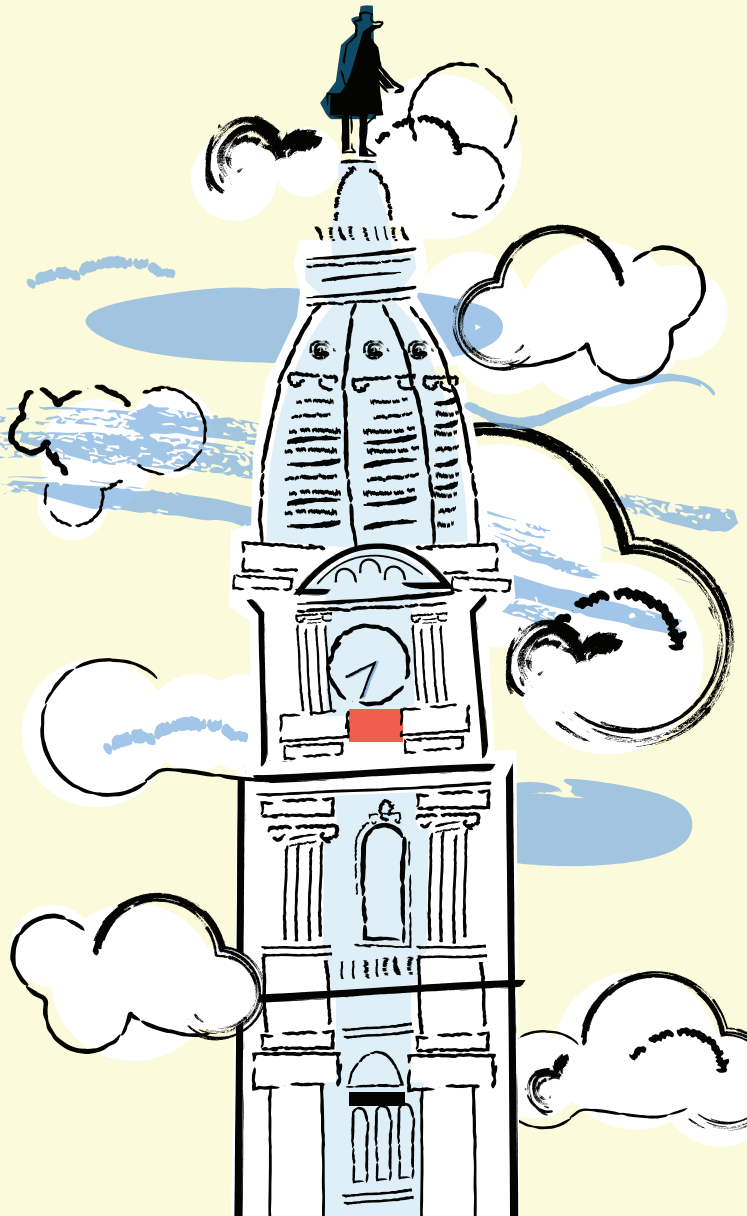
THE GLOBAL PHILADELPHIA ASSOCIATION (GPA)

PHILADELPHIA THE FIRST WORLD HERITAGE CITY IN THE UNITED STATES

Philadelphia joined the Organization of World Heritage Cities on November 5, 2015, thereby becoming the first World Heritage City in the United States. Through this designation, we are part of a community of more than 300 World Heritage Cities around the world. Philadelphia earned this distinction because we are home to a UNESCO World Heritage Site of “outstanding universal value” – Independence Hall – as well as a rich array of historic buildings and cultural sites located throughout the city, including our 67 National Historic Landmarks.
